


The Steering Group of the GISAD 2019/20

Who is part of the Steering Group?


The Steering Group consists of representatives of the various committees of our school.

 - Drafting strategies
 - Delegation of execution tasks
 - Evaluating development processes
- Is commissioned by the committees of the school community and is held accountable
- Discusses, plans and evaluates educational developments together and ensures constant transparency in the respective committees.

Initial situation of pedagogical school development

Continuous school development is an integral part of our school.

We shape school development on three closely interlinked levels:

The institutionalization and continuation of the process on the one hand,

the work on concrete substantive objectives on the other hand, and

the evaluation and examination for sustainability and further development.

We regularly use evaluations to become aware of our strengths and to identify areas in which we need to take action and take measures in order to make progress towards achieving our goals.

The Federal and State Quality Framework for German Schools Abroad, with its 6 quality areas and 29 quality features, provides a quality framework for orientation.

In addition, there are site-specific characteristics that are informed and specified by the local school authority, the Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK) and which are also taken into account.

In **November 2018** our school was visited by the team of the **Bund-Länder-Inspektion**. With great





joy we received again the seal of approval "Excellent German School Abroad".

Due to the Corona crisis we had to switch to distance learning quickly. In order to be close to the interests, wishes and concerns of our students, but also of their parents and the teaching staff, we promptly carried out an evaluation of Distance Learning and immediately introduced appropriate measures.

In June 2020, an **evaluation on distance learning was carried out by ADEK**. Our school was rated in the best possible category 'developed'.

School development planning for the respective school year (action plans)

At the end of each school year, based on the evaluations, the steering group adopts its action plan for school development with a substantive focus for the coming school year.
