## User Agreement

between **John Smith**  
and **Deutsche Internationale Schule in Abu Dhabi**  
concerning the use of the school's IT equipment, WebWeaver and the school's WLAN access.

### General regulations

1. As a general rule the use of any of the school's IT equipment or services is exclusively reserved for academic purposes. This also applies to the use of any digital storage spaces provided by the school.
2. IT rooms and subject-specific rooms (chemistry lab, physics lab, geography lab) with IT equipment must not be accessed without a teacher being present.
3. It is forbidden to eat and drink in the IT rooms. School bags and clothes must not be deposited on desks equipped with computers. Students are not supposed to unplug any cables. Pre-installed preferences on computers must not be changed. Computers must be shut down correctly after usage (LED monitors may have to be switched off separately).
4. IT equipment (computer, smartboard, document camera, etc.) is exclusively reserved for academic purposes and must in no way be used by students without explicit permission and supervision by a teacher.
5. User restrictions imposed by our school's pedagogical filter software are to be fully accepted. The mere attempt to break any restrictions imposed by these filters can result in the instant withdrawal of user privileges. Despite its use of specific pedagogical filters the school cannot fully guarantee that from a technical point of view sites with content subject to criminal prosecution will be blocked in all cases. We firmly express that any access of websites of this kind is strictly forbidden.
6. The use of chats and chatrooms is forbidden. Any commercial transactions (e.g. ebay) via the internet are also strictly banned.
7. Each user bears the responsibility for files that he or she saves on the school's IT equipment including online storage and thereby has to ensure that no legal regulations are breached in any way (e.g. content displaying violence, racism or any other content considered illegal). The school dissociates itself from any content stored on its IT equipment and IT services.
8. Users are taken responsible for any actions performed under their user account. This is why the log in account and the password are to be treated in a fully confidential way. Using someone else's account is strictly forbidden. In case someone is learns about someone else's password the school has to be instantly informed.

### Internet access via WLAN

9. The use of the school's internet is exclusively reserved for the purpose of scholarly research and academic presentation. Legal guidelines and regulations concerning youth protection law, copyright law, and penal law are to be fully observed. Especially copyright regulations concerning films, songs, etc. must not be breached in any way, .e.g by the use of online sharing platforms.
10. Only those IT devices that can technically be fully identified may be used to access the internet.
11. User activities of students can be individually monitored and user protocols can be saved and stored. Any abuse or violations can therefore be identified and penalized.



### WebWeaver

12. When registering for WebWeaver users are provided with a temporary password that must be changed. It is within the responsibility of each user to ensure that the password remains fully confidential and is not passed out to anyone else. Logins are monitored and saved by means of a protocol. The mere attempt to log into someone else's account with login details by trial and error or fraud („hacking“) is considered as theft and will lead to further consequences.
13. Each user is provided with virtual storage space that can be used to save school-related content. Any usage that transcends scholarly or academic purposes affiliated to the school is not allowed. There are no legal titles of users towards the German International School Abu Dhabi concerning the protection of personal data against unauthorized access or use.

Likewise there are no legal claims against German International School Abu Dhabi concerning a loss-less digital backup of any data stored in the network. Furthermore the school does not assume any responsibility for the data security of personal IT devices used at school. There is no way for the school to fully ensure the privacy of data that are transmitted via the internet. The upload of any kind of information onto the internet in any sort of way is to be seen as a deliberate public communication of the content. Consequently there are no legal titles towards German International School Abu Dhabi concerning the protection of these data against unauthorized access and use.

I have read and fully understood the user agreement above.

In my function as user of the school's IT equipment, WebWeaver and the school's WLAN access I hereby declare that I will not breach any term of this agreement. I have been informed that otherwise my user permit may be withdrawn and that further consequences may follow.
